### **Training Syllabus**

The Grayfox will follow the shipboard training programs from the US Coast Guard, Naval Sea Cadet Corps, SeaPerch (STEM), YMCA, and the Grayfox Planned Qualification Systems (PQS) of training. These programs enable a student to become uniquely qualified to operate safely and responsibly on a sea going vessel.

What the Grayfox team can offer:

- Firefighting – learn the need for firefighting tactics with equipment
- Egress drills – learn the exit procedures of the ship
- Damage control – learn to conduct man over board, abandon ship, firefighting and egress drills
- First Aid – learn emergency response on board the ship
- Navigation
- Line handling – learn proper handling and storage of lines
- Ceremonial – conduct color guard activities
- Galley – learn to plan, cook, prepare and clean up from meals
- Signal Flags – learn and use signal flags and ensigns for underway and at dock.
- Watch duties – learn to conduct overnight and underway watches and the use of sound powered radios
- IMC – learn the use of the communication system on board
- Engine room – receive a tour of the engine room
- Close order drill – conduct close order activities on shore
- Marching – conduct marching activities on shore
- YMCA – available in Port Huron for swimming, PT and hygiene breaks
